Level 2 Courses (4.5 GCSE equivalent)

Entry requirements are 2 grade 4s or equivalent qualifications.

There are no minimum entry requirements. If successful in this course you can progress onto the Level 2 Childcare Diploma in the second year.

Our minimum entry requirements for level 3 courses are 5 grade 4s to include at least a grade 4 in Maths or English.
