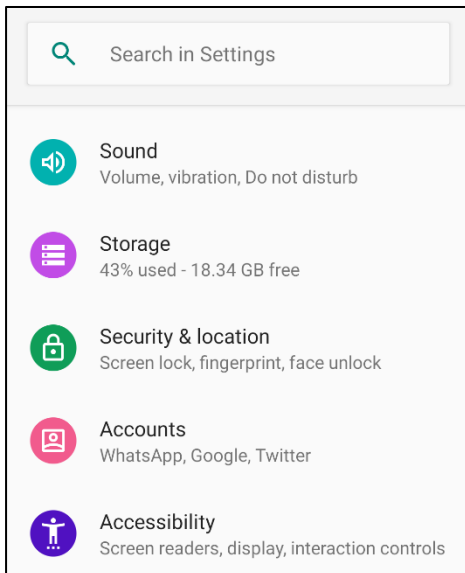


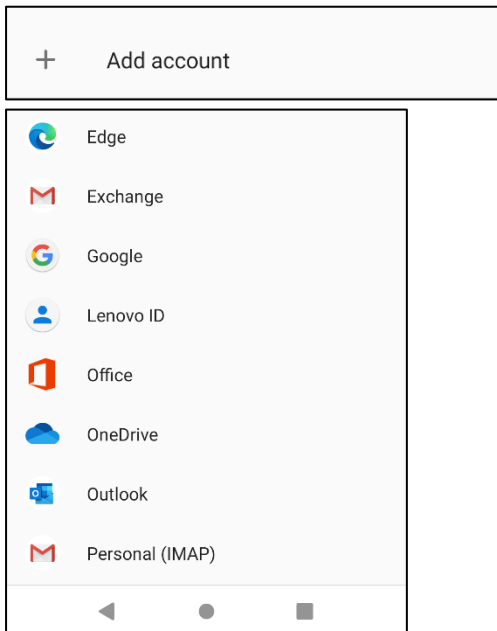
# How to access Google Classroom on Android Devices

## Setup a Work Profile


1. Open your settings app on your device

4. Login with your school email address and password





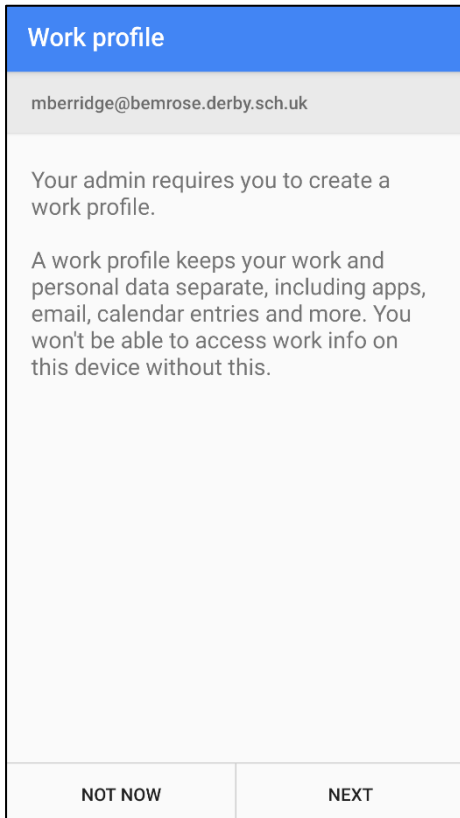
6. Please install the Google Apps Device Policy App



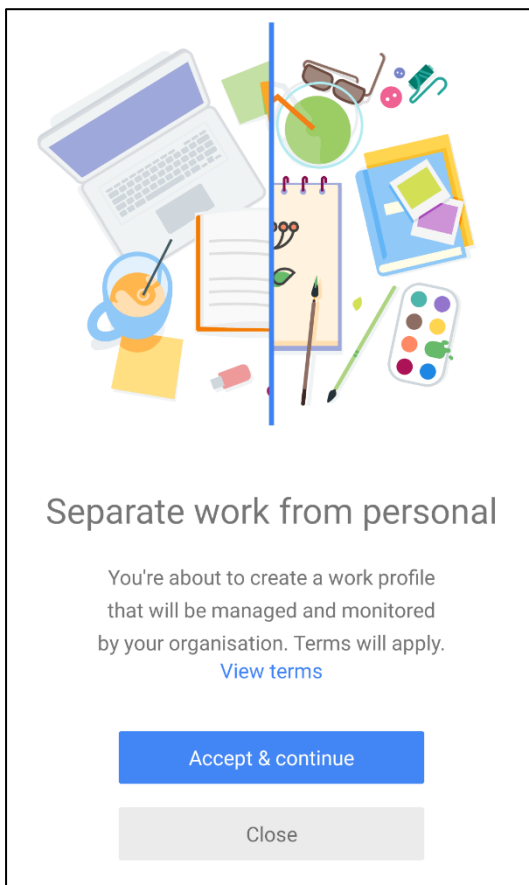
7. Click Next and Allow the device access to any hardware you are happy with



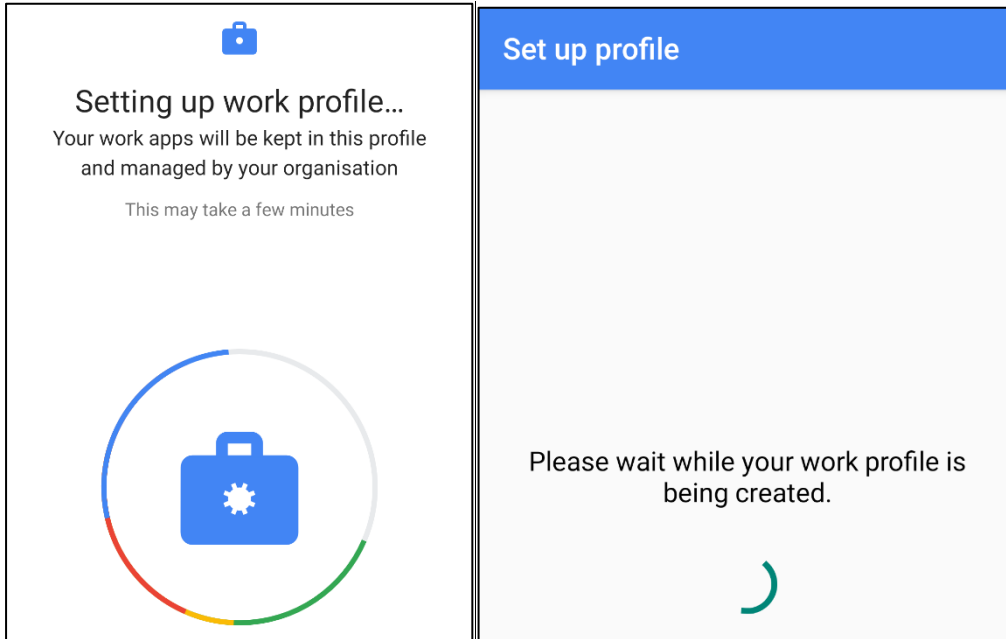
8. Please choose next to setup a work profile



9. Please choose Accept and Continue with any prompts in the app if you agree with the terms and conditions

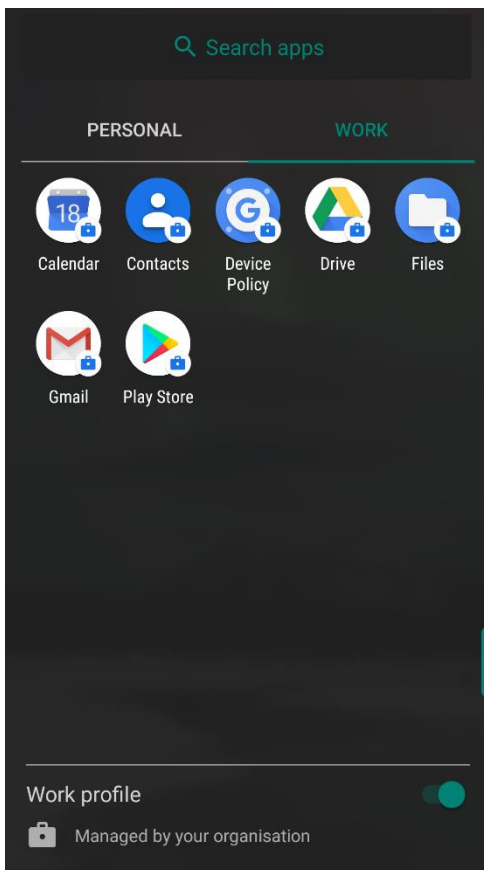


10. The device will then setup the work profile, this may take a few minutes



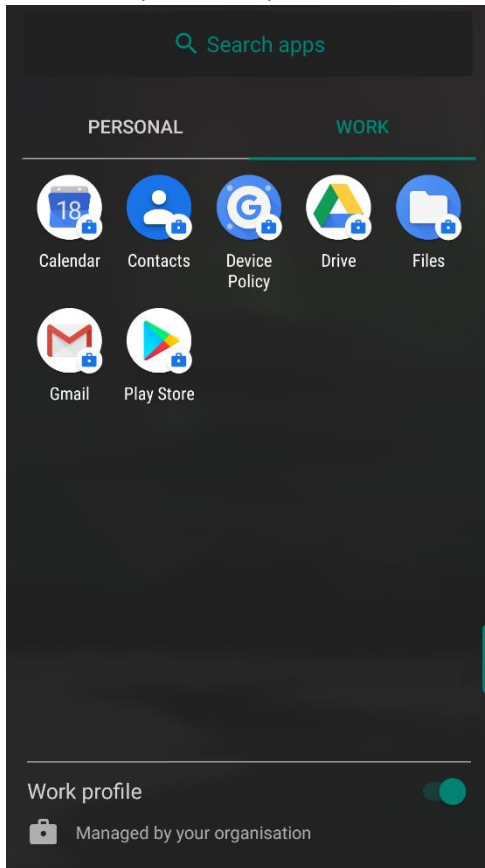
11. Close the app when complete or If the screen doesn't change please click your home button

12. You will now have duplicate copies of some of the main google apps or a new section called Work

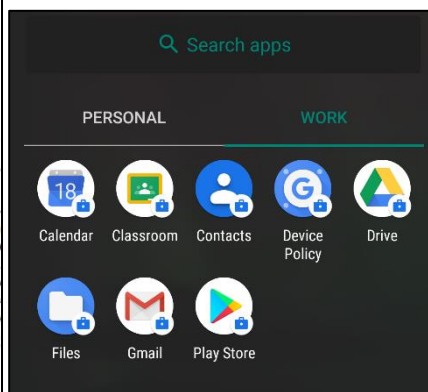
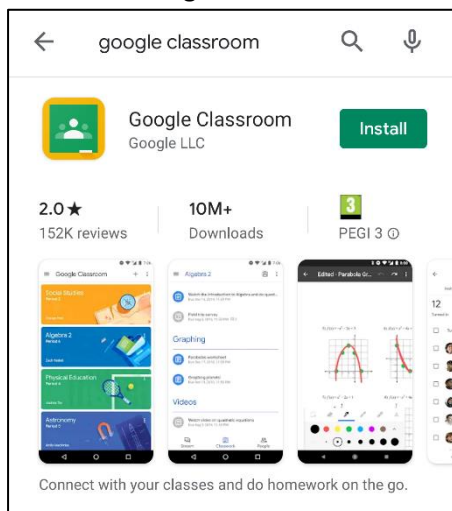


## Download the Google Classroom App

2. Make sure your work profile is turned on

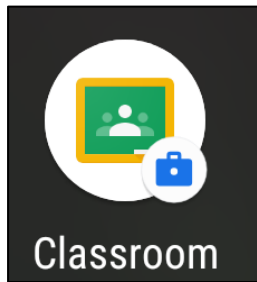


3. Please do not use the normal Play Store as you will not be able to login to Google Classroom

5. Search for Google Classroom and download the App

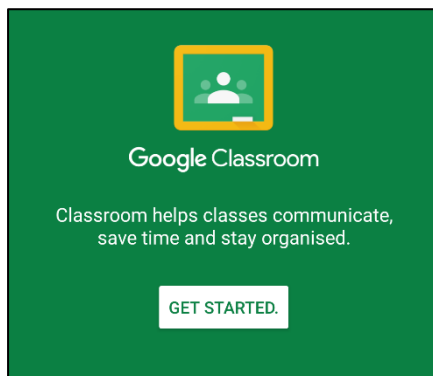


## Login to the App

5. Once you are logged in you will be able to see all your classes and complete work set.
