You will be aware that you have been away from school for too long because of Covid 19. For current year 10 and 12, new year 11 and 13 pupils we plan to open slowly in the coming weeks.

Your form tutor or key member of staff, who has called you weekly, has been or will be in contact to arrange a time for you to come into school on Wednesday 17th or Thursday 18th June. These will be 15-minute appointments with your Form Tutor or key worker then time with an English, maths and science teacher. You do not need to come to school in your school uniform.
