Age Range: Year 4

The aim is for you to complete a minimum of two hours of learning a day with your child. <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Times Tables Rock Stars – complete your set times table task. 2. Prodigy Maths – complete your set task. 3. Fractions: We are continuing with fractions this week. Complete a sheet a day, labelled Day 1 to day 5 from the linked worksheets. Copy into your books or print out if you would like to. Please complete the ** sheets as your main task. If you find them too hard drop to the * sheet and if you want a challenge, complete the *** sheet. Your parents can mark this work as the answers are on the final page. Copy methods suggested on the sheets, please do not write just an answer. 	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Complete a Bug Club activity x 3. 2. Complete the 'Sun Safety' comprehension sheet also on the drop down menu. Answers are on the last page for your parents to use. You can print out or just use screen if you can! 3. 60 Second Speed Read 'A Very Unusual Winter' – set a timer for 1 minute. How far can you read in that time, do you restart? Write it down on the sheet or in your book next to the title, perhaps at the back of your book on the inside cover to keep a record. Then answer the questions, writing out the questions with full sentence answers. 4. Using your school or library book, even a book at home - Write about what a character might be thinking or feeling at different stages of the story. You could write it in the first person or in a speech bubble.

<p>The Prefix 'Anti-'. Activities to learn 10 words for a test Friday. Ask an adult or older brother/sister to help with this part.</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. If you are able, look at the PowerPoint on the use of the prefix 'Anti-'. If you can't do not worry. Spend extra time on this next part of the activity on another day. Then complete the 'Look, Cover, write' activity – either print out or complete in your book – do not forget to cover up the words for the last part. Learn over the week. 2. Complete the word search of the prefix words. 3. Place each word into a sentence, so that it makes sense. 4. Complete the handwriting task – copy the 'Anti-' words, each one 2 lines into your books. 5. Ask your parent to test you on the 10 words 	<p>Activity 1 – Uplevelling Sentences 'A Perfect day on the Beach'. Improve a simple sentence by adding adjectives to modify the noun and make it better. Take each step of the sheet.</p> <p>Activity 2 – Describe the beach in the picture, Can you modify your nouns and verbs?</p> <p>Activity 3 – Plan a piece of writing about 'A Day at the Beach'. Look at the picture from yesterday and pretend you are there. You will pretend that you are back home after a lovely day spent on this beach. Plan by making lists – what did you do? Who did you go with? What did you eat? What did you hear? What did you enjoy? Now organise your day into a story mountain or boxes – the choice is yours.</p> <p>Activity 4 – Draft a diary entry from your planning – you could start with this starter 'Dear diary. Today was the most fantastic day. We travelled by ____ to the beach...' Add your own details within this. You can use your own start.</p> <p>Activity 5 – Edit for our class non-negotiables and then re-write without the mistakes.</p>
