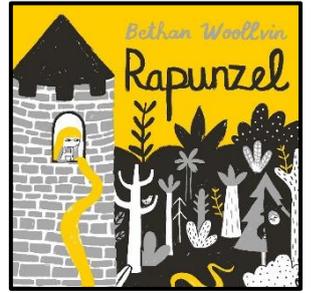


DAY 5 ENGLISH: Friday 5th March

KQ: Can I identify features of a model text?

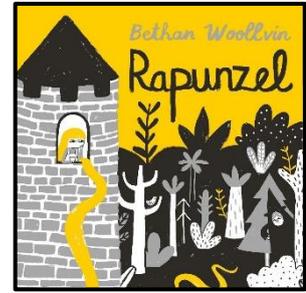

Write down any examples you find. Alternatively, print the model text and make notes on the sheet.

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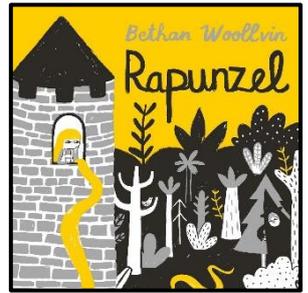
Take a look through the Year 2 spelling list below. How many of these words can you find in the model text? Write them down!
